INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRY 2024

The entry fee is **£35** and this gives you **two tickets** to the Awards evening.
Entries from Charities or Parish Councils *may* be exempt, but in this case only *one ticket* is provided.

Each property nominated requires an A1 display panel for the Awards evening.

If you can produce your own A1 presentation sheet and have it printed to A1 on good quality paper it must be handed to David Burdett at The Heritage Centre, 8, Clarence Road, East Cowes, by **31st May 2024**. The prints will then be mounted on the boards supplied by the organisers.

A Photoshop or PDF template can be supplied – please request this by email to:
iwдца.committee@gmail.com. If you just need the sheet printing, then this can be done for **£15**.

If you are not able to produce your own display board we can design and print your A1 board for £25, payable in addition to the entry fee.
